LICH street outreach provides...

- referrals to eligible resources such as care coordination, mental health treatment, substance use treatment, etc.
- assistance with applying for SNAP and Public Assistance (PA).
- assistance with developing housing plans to exit homelessness and applying for and collecting necessary documentation for eligible housing programs
- an "access point" to Coordinated Entry for Nassau and Suffolk Counties

The eligibility for street outreach services is...

- living outside or in a place not meant for human habitation (in a car, tent, train station, etc.)

LICH Street Outreach prioritizes those experiencing unsheltered homelessness for the longest periods of time for housing focused street outreach (12+ months)

Street Outreach is not...

- crisis or 24/7 response
- Direct access to shelter or DSS (emergency shelter can only be accessed through Department of Social Services)
- Immediate access to housing beyond shelter
